About the Author

David Scott is one of the twelve men to have walked on the Moon. He flew three space missions: first as pilot of *Gemini 8* in 1966, then as command module pilot on *Apollo 9* in 1969, and finally as commander of *Apollo 15* in 1971. He went on to found two private companies, applying his technological expertise in the arena of commercial space, and has also acted as technical advisor on the film *Apollo 13* and Tom Hanks's award-winning series *From the Earth to the Moon*.

Alexei Leonov was born in Siberia in 1934. He was among the first group of cosmonauts selected in 1960 and flew two space missions: first as pilot of *Voskhod 2* in 1965 and then in 1975 as commander of *Soyuz 19* during the Apollo-Soyuz Test Project. He is currently vice president of Russia's Alpha Bank.
